### ORGANIC CONVERSATION (WHAT SPOKE TO YOU FROM THIS WEEK'S WORSHIP GATHERING?)

As we took a look at Jonah on Sunday, it's easy for us to make a statement like, "Jonah missed the point. How could he not get that God loved the people of Nineveh?" It's one thing to say that you'll love all the difficult, sinful people in your life, but totally different when you come face to face with it in real life!

Has there been a time in your life where you had a difficult time having compassion on the people God had placed in your life to love? Why?

Are you currently struggling with seeing people the way God sees them? Co-worker, another parent, a family member, a public figure, a Christian brother or sister, your spouse?

How does understanding your own brokenness (and God's love and forgiveness to you in spite of it) help you offer grace to others? If you need to, review Matthew 18:21-35.

THE THREADS OF SCRIPTURE (ADDITIONAL BIBLE PASSAGES FOR STUDY/DISCUSSION) Scripture: Mark 12:30-31

Jesus says that "the second (command) is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Some questions:

Who are the "neighbors" in your life? Who are the ACTUAL neighbors? Have you reached out to them? If not, what might be a next step?

What does loving your neighbor "as yourself" look like?
